

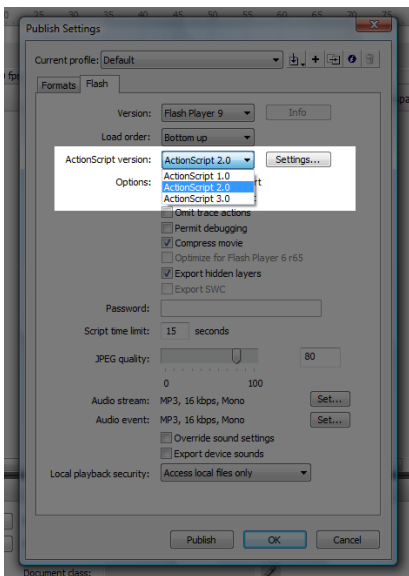
## Flash Banners **ActionScript 2.0**

Before uploading your Flash banners, you need to make sure you have correctly published them (for iDevAffiliate) at the time of creation. If you don't follow this procedure, your Flash banners will not be clickable links and your affiliates won't be able to send you customers. This tutorial assumes you have basic knowledge of Adobe Flash.

### Step 1 – Publish Settings

Make sure you have the ActionScript version set to **ActionScript 2.0**.

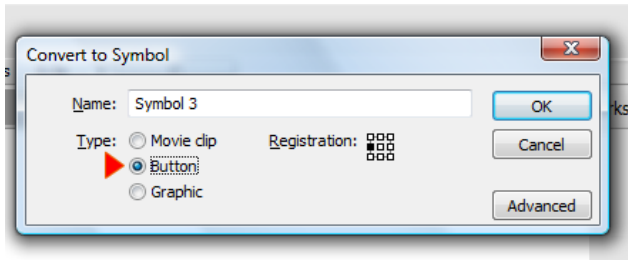
- 1) Open Adobe Flash
- 2) Open your Flash banner
- 3) Go to: “File > Publish Settings > Flash”
- 4) Change, “ActionScript version” to **ActionScript 2.0**
- 5) Click, “OK”



### Step 2 - Creating Your Button

You have two options here. Option one is to select your banner and turn it into a button. Option two is to create a transparent layer over your banner that can be used as the area people will click on. The point to the second option is that it's easier than converting to a MovieClip/Button, while keeping layers intact.

Once you have selected your banner, press F8. This will give you the option to create a Movie Clip, Button, or Graphic. You will want to click “Button”. **Please Note:** other options will work as well, but won't have the hand cursor by default on hover.



## Step 4 – ActionScript

In the final step, we are going to add the following ActionScript code to your button. To open the actions panel, click to select your button, and press F9. You can also right click on your button, and select “Actions”. Enter the code below into your first frames actions. **Please Note:** where it says URL\_HERE, enter your URL:

```
on (release) {  
    getURL("URL_HERE ");  
}
```

## Step 5 - Test

To test, you can click “Control > Test Movie” or click CTRL+ENTER.
