


Creating A Paypal Button

Use this guide to create a Paypal buynow, add-to-cart or subscription button that works with iDevAffiliate.

Step 1. Enable Paypal as your cart to integrate with in the shopping cart wizard of iDevAffiliate.

iDevAffiliate Admin Center: Cart Integration (menu at top) > Shopping Cart Integration



Step 2. Create your Paypal button in your Paypal account.

Paypal Admin Center: Merchant Services (menu at top) > Then choose a button type under **Create Buttons**.






Step 3. During the button creation process you will need to do two things.

A) In step 2 entitled "Track inventory, profit & loss (optional)" uncheck the **Save button at Paypal** option.



B) On the next page where you get the code click **Remove code protection**.



Step 4. Take the two lines of code provided in your iDevAffiliate admin center and add them to your button code.

iDevAffiliate Admin Center: Cart Integration (menu at top) > Integration Profiles & Instructions then click **View Integration Instructions & Processing Code** next to paypal.

Final code should look something like this.

Step 5. Place your Paypal code into your website where you want your button to appear.

Note 1: This button code MUST be placed into a page on your website that has a PHP extension. So if you have for example a page that is named **purchase.html** that will need renamed to **purchase.php**. Why? Because as you can see in the above screenshot you're adding a piece of PHP code to your Paypal button which means the button must be on a page ending with .php.

Note2: If you've done everything in this guide and a commission doesn't come in you may need to also edit your IPN settings in your Paypal settings. Enable the use of IPN in your Paypal account and set the URL to the same URL defined as the "notify_url" in your Paypal above.

In the above screenshot for example, that would be:

http://www.yoursite.com/idevaffiliate/paypal_ipn_buynow.php

This will vary depending on the type of button you're using and of course the domain name and possibly the folder name will be different.
